Tea Trivia



Did you know?

The terms "Afternoon Tea" and "High
Tea" have different meanings.

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Traditionally, Afternoon Tea is a dainty
meal served at 4 pm with an array of
scones, small sandwiches, and pastries.

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Anna, Duchess of Bedford, devised
Afternoon Tea in 1840 as a way to satisfy
her appetite between breakfast and
dinner, not served until 8 pm.

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High Tea is historically the "workingman's
supper," a meal of hot meat, cheese,
and egg dishes served at 6pm in rural
England.

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Milk (not cream!) is to be poured into
the cup before the tea to best bring
out the tea's flavor. Lemon and milk
are not used together, as the
lemon will curdle the milk.

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A "Cream Tea" refers to Devonshire or
Clotted Cream served with scones, made
from fresh unpasteurized milk. Mock
Devonshire cream is now served.

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Tea is the most widely consumed
beverage in the world, 2nd only to water!
